

School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Hanley International Academy. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

In reviewing the combined report and reviewing trend data and data from 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years, Hanley International Academy has already initiated key strategies to accelerate student achievement and close the persistent gaps in achievement. This past year we restructured our Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) Team and English Learner Teams. We focused on developing a schedule that allows for them to push into the various grade levels during center-based activities for

ELA and Math. This allowed for focused and coordinated services and better collaboration with the general education teachers and support staff. In addition, a more persistent approach to Science and Social Studies with dedicated times and increased project-based learning was incorporated. The annual report showed we increased in ELA in 3rd, 5th and 7th grades. We saw a 16.1% increase in 3rd with male students increasing the most at 20%. 4th, 6th and 8th grades saw decreases with 4th decreasing 2.2%, 6th decreasing 16.5% and 8th grade decreasing 3.2%. Females tended to trail behind their male counterparts in these particular grades. Math saw increases in 3rd, 5th, and 7th grades as well and decreases in 4th, 6th, and 8th. Our economically disadvantaged students led the increases with 29.5% increases in 3rd grade, 6.9% in 5th grade and 6.1% increases in 7th grade. Science and Social Studies saw significant increases with 11.7% in each content area. 8th grade Science and Social Studies saw declines of 13.7% in 5th grade and 6.9% in 8th grade respectively. Overall, our scores are showing strong growth and proficiency. We are excited about the effects of the new structure already. Progress on the National Assessment of Education Progress (NAEP) shows similar consistency and our number of certified instructors remains high at 87% and over 60% are experienced teachers with over 3 years of teaching experience.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Hanley International Academy is a public charter school. In 2022-2023 and 2023-2024, we held an open enrollment period in which we publicly posted the dates and times. We accept applications for the upcoming school year. If all of our slots are full, we then hold a public lottery to fill the spaces. To date, we have accepted all of the applications, filled the spots accordingly, and filled those spots according to our waitlist.

2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Hanley International Academy's School Improvement Plan was reviewed in 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 and is reviewed yearly and updated by the School Improvement Team. The team is comprised of representatives from each grade level and also includes representatives from Administration, general education teachers, special education, English language and also the encore departments. New goals have been developed based on the needs identified in the current data along with strategies and activities to accompany these goals. Frequent needs assessments and progress monitoring is conducted to ensure progression of the School Improvement Plan.

3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

For 2022-2023 and 2023-2024, Hanley has operated as a Pre-Kindergarten through 8th grade school. We offer Encore classes in Art, Physical Education, Health and Academic Enrichment. We offer a comprehensive Special Education Department, English Language Learner program and Response to Intervention Team/Multi-Tiered System of Supports. Hanley International Academy is not a specialized school.



Hanley International Academy utilized The Romine Group (TRG) pacing guides for all core subject and specials areas for 2022-2023 and 2023-2024. This curriculum and the curricular tools to support are aligned to the Common Core State Standards. Routinely, the District Improvement Team realigns and maps program implementation to ensure coverage and mastery of the Common Core State Standards as adopted by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). There is no variance from the state's model. Copies of the curriculum can be found on the Hanley website or a copy may be picked up in the Main Office.


5. THE AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS FOR ANY LOCAL COMPETENCY TESTS OR NATIONALLY NORMED ACHIEVEMENT TESTS

In 2022-2023 and 2023-2024, we did administer NWEA (Northwest Evaluation Association)/MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) to all grades Kindergarten through eighth grades. NWEA is a nationally normed achievement test that measures individual student growth as well as achievement. We administered the test in both English Language Arts (ELA) and Math. The test is given three times a year, once each in the fall, winter and spring. This data is used to help measure the strengths and weaknesses of all our students. We use this data in conjunction with our other data to tailor instruction and make curriculum adjustments.

6. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

Hanley International Academy continues to celebrate a strong participation rate in parent teacher conferences. Every year we have two sets of conferences. The first round of conferences is mandatory for all parents. For the 2022-2023, we saw 587 of our students out of 667 or 88%. During the 2023-2024 school year, we saw 606 out of 664 of our students or 91%. The second round of conferences are held for those students who were exhibiting academic difficulties or other barriers or concerns that needed to be addressed with the parents before the end of the school year. In 2022-2023 we had a 100% participation rate, while 2023-2024 spring participation rate was 222 students out of 228 students or 97%. Conference participation continues to remain strong and consistent throughout the years.
